FALL CONVENTION REHEARSAL SPACE ASSIGNMENTS BEGUN

RMD Events VP Kevin Pape has begun assigning chorus rehearsal space for the Fall Convention, based on timely submission of "intent to compete" letters. Choruses that have been assigned rehearsal space are now free to make lodging reservations (obviously most convenient to their rehearsal space). He will continue to place choruses in the order received, but be aware that on July 16 the room blocks will OPEN TO ANYONE making plans to attend the Convention. Choruses could find themselves split up because there may not be a single block of rooms in one hotel sufficient to accommodate everyone. Before this happens to you...contact Kevin Pape (after the International Convention) with your "intent to compete", get your rehearsal space assignment, then do your best to get rooms together close to your rehearsal space...and do this BEFORE July 16.
