Please do not use that address until August 27th. You should no longer be mailing things to Kenosha; although we will get forwarded mail, I'm sure it will take longer than usual. E-mail addresses remain the same. 1-800-876-7464 (SING) will be available before, during, and after the move. If you can't get through, keep trying. “Permission to arrange” and other Harmony Marketplace orders will be filled slowly (no wise cracks, please!) Please order well in advance of need. Servers will be sporadic during the move. Please try repeatedly if you are rejected at first.

Aug 20th to the 24th is moving week. The moving trucks will be loading in Kenosha.

Aug 24th is the last day of business in Kenosha.

Aug 27th to the 31st is move in week in Nashville. The moving trucks will be unloading in Nashville. The 800 number should work, but staff access will be limited. You may be transferred from the 800 number to cell phones of the staff members. Of course, service will be limited, but your call will be noted and addressed as necessary. Sept 4th headquarters reopens for business in Nashville. Many of the staff members will be new and/or temporary, so your patience is requested.
