RMD LEADERSHIP SEMINARS

Next Saturday (October 13) will be the first of three regional “Leadership Seminars” (District-sponsored training replacing “COTS”).

Denver (at the Stapleton Radisson) is the place to be for all chapters that are not closer to Albuquerque (Nov 3) or Salt Lake City (Nov 17). Registration begins at 8:00 AM and the event is over at 5:00 PM. Remember that lunch will be “on your own” but economical meal plans will be offered to save both time and \$\$\$. For anyone traveling into Denver and needing overnight lodging, room rates have been negotiated at the Radisson.

Tuition (collected at registration on site) is \$25 per attendee up to a maximum of \$75 per chapter (in other words, after your chapter pays tuition for 3 attendees, any additional attendees pay NO tuition).

There are **FOUR TRACKS** being offered.

1. **President** (leadership in areas of governance and management and chapter legal operations including oversight of Secretary, Treasurer, and chapter board of directors and operations team)
2. **Music** (leadership in areas related to music and its performance).
3. **Internal Operations** (leadership in areas related to members and programs that benefit the membership)
4. **External Operations** (leadership in areas related to marketing and public relations and outreach and events and service...income and expenses of the chapter operational bank account)

While many specifics of operation will be discussed, the primary focus of these sessions is **LEADERSHIP**. This team of 4 leaders can effectively oversee all functions within the chapter, and if they effectively communicate with each other and with other functional leaders in the chapter and with the chapter membership in general, things will get done instead of falling through the cracks.

Chapter planning will be facilitated by Lee Taylor and Chapter Counselors, who will work with these leaders through the coming year to see the plans through. This is practical planning consistent with each individual chapter vision / mission, and responsible ownership of action items to make these plans reality.

No chapter can afford to MISS this opportunity to learn and plan for success, and the minimal tuition reflects the District’s concern for any financial obstacle that would prohibit attendance. If someone is driving, FILL THE CAR.

And, yes, you’ll learn a new song...this will be FUN, too!
